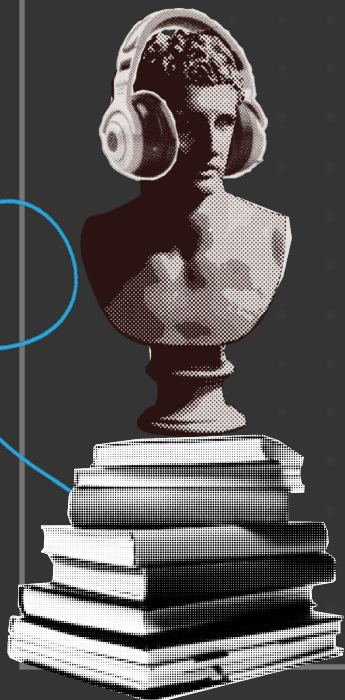

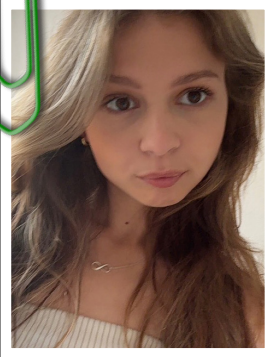

improve accessibility and equity. I am committed to leadership, advocacy and inclusive change.

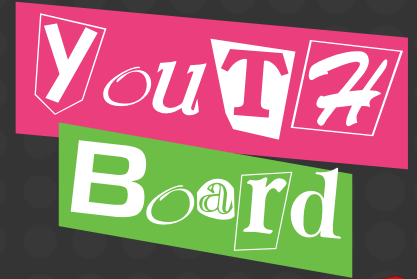
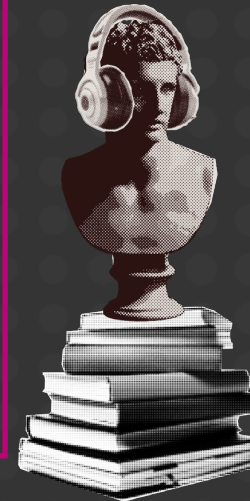

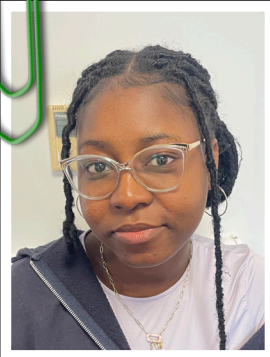
I'm a Beauty Therapy student involved in multiple programmes. My journey with Unloc has transformed me into a confident and talkative person, shaping my character and personality. My goal in

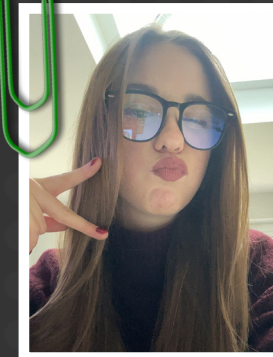


Age: 17

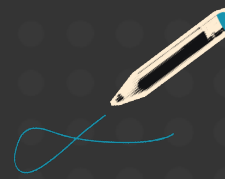

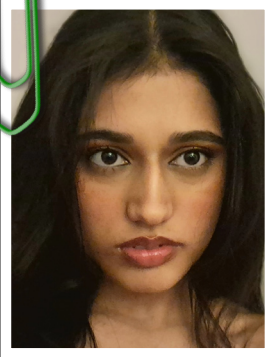

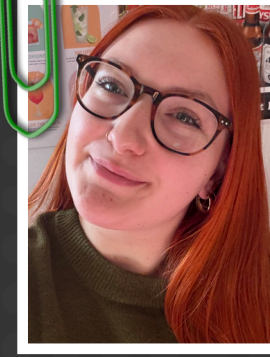


Age: 16

Mackenzie

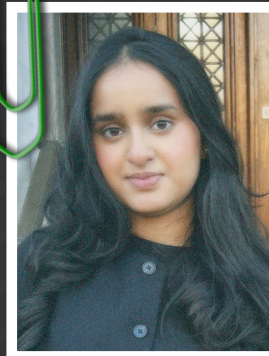


Age: 18

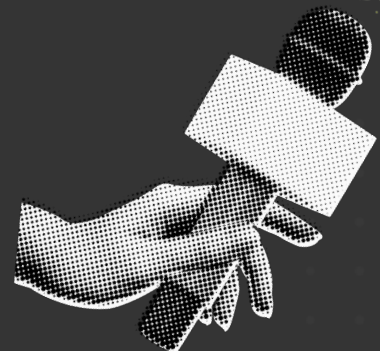


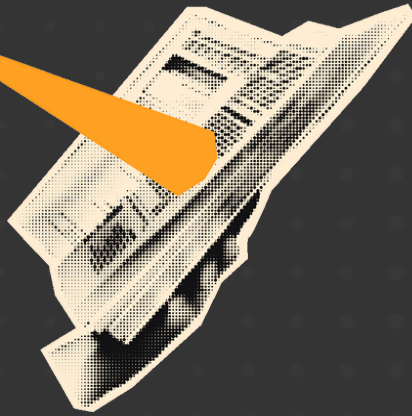
Age: 17

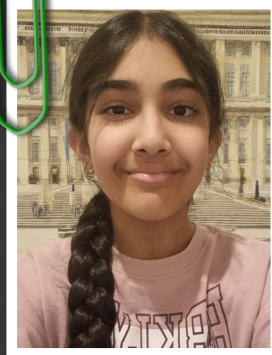
Our Youth Board members come from schools and colleges around the country, representing young leaders from a wide variety of backgrounds, communities and cultures

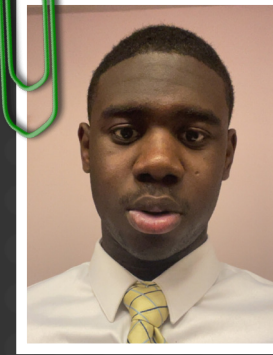


Age: 13

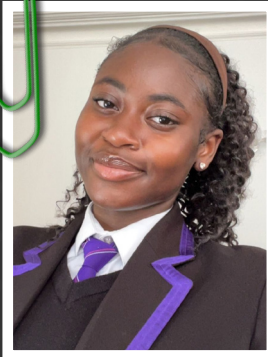

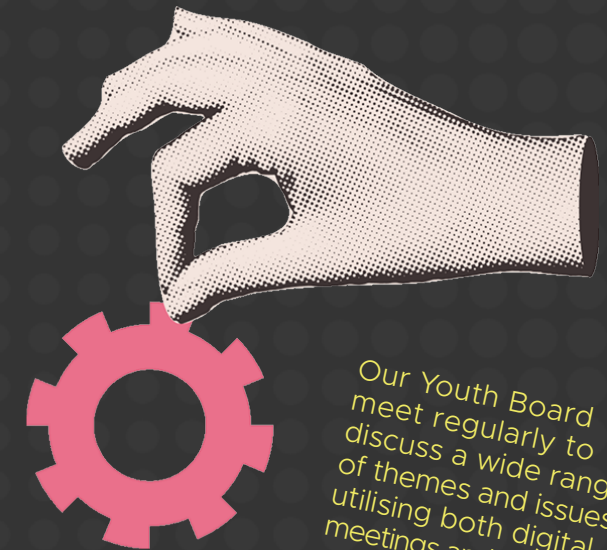
Oluwaseyi

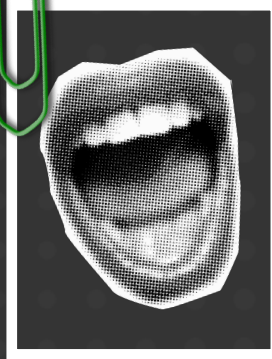

Amina



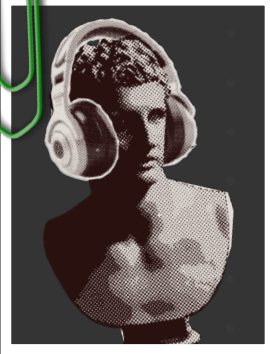
Age: 16

Nevaeh

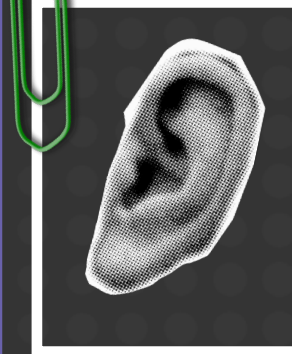

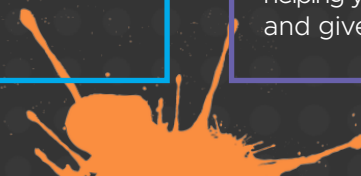

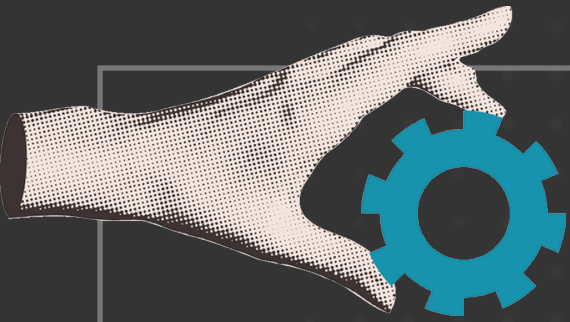
